

Many low-income schools are forced to budget and pay for teachers based on “average” teacher salaries, but actually tend to have more novice, less experienced teachers. The discrepancies found in comparing *actual* teacher salaries in Title I versus non-Title one schools are stark, especially in the schools highlighted below.
